



MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: April 1, 2021

On April 1, 2021, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of two additional positive cases of COVID-19 impacting individuals in the Grade 5 -6 split class at College Park School.

All students in the grade 5-6 split class were identified as close contacts by Public Health on March 29, 2021, and given self-isolation instructions. **Public Health will be contacting guardians of all students in the 5-6 split class to provide further direction on revised isolation instructions.** Communication has been shared with the classroom and school community.

We all have a shared responsibility to decrease the risk of COVID-19 entering schools. Students and families are reminded to be diligent in performing the daily health screening, stay home if ill, call HealthLine 811 if exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, practice proper hand hygiene, maintain physical distancing as much as possible, wear a mask when appropriate, and do everything we can to keep each other safe.

The Lloydminster Public School Division and College Park School Administration and staff, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to keep student and staff well-being as our priority.
