

MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: May 7, 2021

On May 7, 2021, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of a positive case of COVID-19 impacting an individual in the grade 2 class at Jack Kemp Community School.

Students in the room 108 grade 2 class have been identified as close contacts by Public Health and are required to begin immediate self-isolation.

Communication has been shared with the school community.

We all have a shared responsibility to decrease the risk of COVID-19 entering schools. Students and families are reminded to be diligent in performing the daily health screening, stay home if ill, call HealthLine 811 if exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, practice proper hand hygiene, maintain physical distancing as much as possible, wear a mask when appropriate, and do everything we can to keep each other safe.

The Lloydminster Public School Division and Jack Kemp Community School Administration and staff, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to keep student and staff well-being as our priority.
