## Discuss/ Hammer Throw Cage at LCHS

Over the summer, the Division was approached by the Split City Sonics Track and Field Club regarding the construction of a new cage for the Discuss and Hammer Throw.

Mid-August, Director of Education Todd Robinson and Facilities Manager Bernard Gautier met with the LloydminsterComprehensive High School Administration and representatives of the Split City Sonics to discuss the project. ## Budget Report
