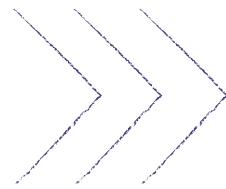


# LPSD's February Scavenger Hunt

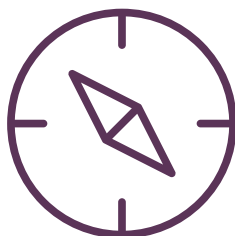
Go for a walk in your community and count how many people have some type of article covering the top of their head (eg; hat, toque, scarf, etc.)
