PROGRAM STRUCTURE

- Two on ice and two off ice sessions per week.
- Time for the Academy will replace instructional time typically received for physical education and health.
- Students do not miss out on any academic curricular lessons.
- Certified Teachers accompany and support the learning of all students.
- The Academy provides the highest quality of instructors with a low student-to-instructor ratio.
- Approximately 80 hours of on ice training from September to June.
- Students participate in an enhanced Phys Ed program that will challenge the athletes mind and body to adapt to new sports and new challenges.
- Upon acceptance students will attend Rendell Park Elementary School, College Park School or Bishop Lloyd Middle School.
- Parents are responsible for pickup of student and equipment on academy days at Servus Sports Centre

REGISTRATION AND FEES

Early registration deadline is May 5.

Students who register before or on May 5th will receive \$100 off their fees.

Registration opens March 26.

Fees in 2019/20 for the year totaled \$1,950 per child and then \$1,750 for each additional sibling, being paid in monthly installments.

We are working on determining tuition for 2020/21. We can guarantee that the cost will not be increased from the 2019/2020 school year.

In the past, we required a \$400 deposit with registation, however, in these unprecedented times this will not be required.




