



## MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: October 23, 2020

On October 22, 2020, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of a positive case of COVID-19 in the community of Lloydminster which has impacted individuals at E.S. Laird Middle School. Public Health has acted rapidly with their contact tracing process.

In consultation with Public Health, and to minimize further risk of transmission within the school and community E.S. Laird students in classrooms 8C and 9E will be moving to online learning from October 27th till October 29th. All other students will continue with regular classes on Tuesday, October 27th.

Based on the advice of the Local Medical Health Officer, students of 8C and 9E will return to school on Friday, October 30th.

Communication has been shared with the specific classrooms, as well as the school community.

“Our school administration is working diligently to communicate information as we receive it, with our parents and caregivers, and will continue to work to ensure minimal disruption to student learning.” - Todd Robinson, Director of Education

The Lloydminster Public School Division and E.S. Laird Middle School Administration, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to communicate additional information as it is available.
