



MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: November 1, 2020

On November 1, 2020, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of a positive case of COVID-19 in the community of Lloydminster which has impacted individuals at Winston Churchill Elementary School. The SHA is conducting contact tracing.

To protect privacy, we are not able to share or discuss details.

In consultation with Public Health, and to minimize further risk of transmission within the school and community classroom 301 grade 1 and classroom 509 grade 3 will be moving to online learning from November 2 till November 6th. Students will return to school on November 16th, after the fall break.

Communication has been shared with the specific classrooms, as well as the school community.

Our school plans contain many important measures, processes, and protocols which add layers of protection for students and staff.
