On November 2, 2020, officials from the Saskatchewan Health Authority identified a positive COVID-19 case in an individual at Lloydminster Comprehensive High School in Lloydminster.

Communication has been shared with the specific classrooms, as well as the school community. The SHA is conducting contact tracing.

To protect privacy, we are not able to share or discuss details.

Our school plans contain many important measures, processes, and protocols which add layers of protection for students and staff.

“We are all in this together. Students and families are asked to please be diligent in monitoring their daily health and if ill to please remain at home. If students or family members are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms please follow up with Public Health by calling the Healthline at 811 for further instructions.” - Todd Robinson, Director of Education
