



MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: November 2, 2020

On the evening of November 2, 2020, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of a positive case of COVID-19 in the community of Lloydminster which has impacted individuals at E.S. Laird Middle School.

In consultation with Public Health, and to minimize further risk of transmission within the school and community **all classes will be canceled on Tuesday, November 3rd** and all E.S. Laird students will be moving to online learning from November 4th until November 16th. From November 9th to 13th there will be no online learning due to the November break. All students will resume with regular classes on Tuesday, November 17th.

Communication has been shared with the school community.

“Student and Staff well-being is our top priority and will continue to remain at the forefront as we navigate this positive case that is impacting our school. Collaboratively with SHA and Public Health a school closure was advised to minimize further risks of transmission.” - Todd Robinson, Director of Education

The Lloydminster Public School Division and E.S. Laird Middle School Administration, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to communicate additional information as it becomes available.
