



MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: December 3, 2020

On December 3, 2020, officials from the Saskatchewan Health Authority identified a positive COVID-19 case in an individual in the 7B/7D cohort at E.S. Laird Middle School in Lloydminster.

Communication has been shared with the specific classrooms/cohorts, as well as the school community. To protect privacy, we are not able to share or discuss details.

All students in classroom 7D have been in isolation since November 29th, the isolation period has been extended by Public Health from December 8th to December 11th at midnight.

In addition, all students in classroom 7B have been identified as close contacts in this case by Public Health and are required to self-isolate until December 11th at midnight.

We all have a shared responsibility to decrease the risk of COVID-19 entering schools. Students and families are reminded to be diligent in performing the daily health screening, stay home if ill, call HealthLine 811 if exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, practice proper hand hygiene, maintain physical distancing as much as possible, wear a mask when appropriate, and do everything we can to keep each other safe.

The Lloydminster Public School Division and E.S. Laird School Administration, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to communicate additional information as it becomes available.
