

MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: March 23, 2021

On March 23, 2021, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of two positive cases of COVID-19 at College Park School, one in the grade 5-6 cohort and one in the grade 9 cohort.

Public Health has completed its contact tracing process in relation to the grade 5-6 cohort case and close contacts have been identified, contacted, and provided with further direction.

Public Health has begun its contact tracing process for the grade 9 cohort case. Grade 9 students impacted have been asked to stay at home until the conclusion of Public Health's contact tracing process.

We remind everyone entering schools to monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Refer to the Daily Self-Assessment Checklist. Please complete this before attending school each day.

If you/your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, please call HealthLine at 811 and remain at home. If medical attention is required, please call ahead to your health care provider. If it is an emergency requiring urgent attention, call 911.

The Lloydminster Public School Division and College Park School Administration and staff, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to keep student and staff well-being as our priority.
