



MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: March 29, 2021

On March 29, 2021, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of a positive case of COVID-19 impacting an individual in the Grade 5 /6 class at College Park School.

All students in grade 5 /6 have been identified as close contacts by Public Health and are required to begin immediate self-isolation.

We remind everyone entering schools to monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Refer to the Daily Self-Assessment Checklist. Please complete this before attending school each day.

If you/your child has any symptoms of COVID-19, please call HealthLine at 811 and remain at home. If medical attention is required, please call ahead to your health care provider. If it is an emergency requiring urgent attention, call 911.

The Lloydminster Public School Division and College Park School Administration and staff, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to keep student and staff well-being as our priority.
