



## MEDIA STATEMENT

Date of release: April 15, 2021

On April 15, 2021, the Saskatchewan Health Authority advised Lloydminster Public School Division of a positive case of COVID-19 impacting an individual in classroom 509 grade 3 at Winston Churchill School.

Public Health will be completing their contact tracing process tomorrow, Friday, April 16th. All students in classroom 509 grade 3 are requested to stay home until further direction is given by Public Health.

Communication has been shared with the classroom and school community.

We all have a shared responsibility to decrease the risk of COVID-19 entering schools. Students and families are reminded to be diligent in performing the daily health screening, stay home if ill, call HealthLine 811 if exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms, practice proper hand hygiene, maintain physical distancing as much as possible, wear a mask when appropriate, and do everything we can to keep each other safe.

The Lloydminster Public School Division and Winston Churchill School Administration and staff, with the support of Public Health and the SHA, will continue to keep student and staff well-being as our priority.
